Technical Assistance from Higher Education Institutions

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Assistance Sources

- Workshops/Special Classes
- Grant/Contract-based Research Projects
- Consultation
- Community Service
- Internships

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Workshops/Special Classes

- Uses existing institutional resources
- Campus-based, site-based, or distance learning
- Self-improvement or client delivery
- Continuing education credit
- Examples
 - Collaboration with Denver Water on western water issues
 - Collaboration with Denver Museum on endangered species issues
 - Implications of "takings" on environmental regulation

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Grant/Contract Research

- A requirement of university employment for many faculty members
- Get what you need
 - Grants vary from open-ended to highly specific
 - Contracts imply recompense for work/product
- RFP shopping list
- Operate through the institution
- Overhead costs vary among institutions and may reduce the budget for deliverables

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Consultation Usually services for a fee Typically carried out by faculty members acting as individuals

- Advantages
 - greater flexibility in scheduling
 - reduced overhead
- Disadvantages
 - lack of institutional authority
 - lack of institutional support services

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Community Service

- A requirement of university employment for many faculty members
- Usually volunteer activity
- Government agencies and non-profit NGOs
 - Greeley Citizen's Planning Advisory Committee
 - Northern Front Range Solid Waste Action Group
 - Conservation/environmental groups
 - Colorado Alliance for Environmental Education
 - Colorado Wildlife Federation
 - National Wildlife Federation

Internships

- Practical experience for students and extension of service capacity for agency
- Variable in time commitment
 - 25-30 hours of service per hour of academic credit
 - $-\,$ 10 hours a week to essentially fulltime work
- Paid vs. unpaid
 - stipends (token to substantial)
 - housing or travel support
 - liability implications

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Internship Considerations

- It should be of clear mutual benefit
- Task types
 - clerical work, research, client outreach, service delivery, business consulting, community organizing
 develop progressive responsibility for the intern
- Evaluation
 - reflective journal
 - research paper
 - letter from supervisor
